Punjab:
The province is expected to experience scattered rainfall, thunderstorm, windstorm, and isolated hailstorm in districts including Rawalpindi, Islamabad, Murree, Attock, Chakwal, Gujar Khan, Jhelum, Mandi Bahaudin, Lahore, Gujrat, Sialkot, Gujranwala, Narowal, Multan, Sahiwal, Okara, Faisalabad, Kasur, Bahawalnagar, Bahawalpur, and surrounding areas on 28 to 31 May. The province is expected to remain mainly hot and dry with rising temperatures during this period.

Balochistan:
The province is expected to experience scattered rainfall, thunderstorm, windstorm, and isolated hailstorm in districts including Quetta, Zhob, Ziarat, Chaman, Khuzdar, Turbat, and surrounding areas from 30 to 31 May. The province is expected to remain mainly hot and dry and emperature will also steadily rise throughout the province.

Sindh:
The province is expected to experience scattered rainfall, thunderstorm, windstorm, and isolated hailstorm in districts including Karachi, Thatta, Badin, Mithi, Hyderabad, and surrounding areas on 30 to 31 May. The province is expected to remain mainly hot and dry from 26 to 31 May. Temperature will also steadily rise throughout the province.



KP:
The province is expected to experience isolated rainfall, thunderstorm, windstorm, and isolated hailstorm in districts including Chitral, Dir, Mingora, Batkhela, Parachinar, Mansehra, Abbotabad, Haripur, Hangu, Swat, Ghoriwala, and surrounding areas from 26 to 31 May. The province is expected to remain mainly hot and dry and temperature will also steadily rise throughout the province.

GB & AJK:
The province is expected to experience isolated rainfall, thunderstorm, windstorm, and isolated hailstorm in districts including Gilgit, Skardu, Hunza, Ghizer, Diamer, Astore, Neelum Valley, Muzaffarabad, Poonch, Bhimber, Kotli, Bagh, Garhi Duppatta, Kahuta, and surrounding areas from 29 to 31 May. The province is expected to remain mainly hot and dry from 26 to 31 May. Temperature will also steadily rise throughout the province.
