Hazard Summary

Extreme cold persists across northern Canada, with temperatures dropping below – **50°C**, particularly in the Yukon, and conditions expected to continue into the New Year.

The severe freeze may lead to **power outages, frostbite risk, and infrastructure strain** in affected regions.

In contrast, parts of the **United States** are experiencing record-breaking warmth, with temperatures **15–30°C above average**.

Residents are advised to **take necessary precautions** against both extreme cold and unseasonable heat.
