




Massive Rainfall in North India



Valid: From January 23rd, 2025 to January 27th, 2026

Affected Areas

Most affected areas include: North India, Uttarakhand foothills, Jammu & Kashmir, Himachal Pradesh, Western Uttar Pradesh, North Haryana and Punjab. Severely affected areas include: Upper Western Uttar Pradesh, Eastern Haryana, Chandigarh region, and Lower Himalayan foothills.

Hazard Types

Flash & urban flooding, Riverine flooding in low-lying basins, Landslides & slope failures (foothills), Severe thunderstorms & lightning, Transport and infrastructure disruption.

Hazard Summary

An active monsoon-western disturbance interaction is producing widespread and heavy rainfall across northern India, particularly over the Indo-Gangetic plains and Himalayan foothills. Repeated rainfall episodes will heighten the risk of flash flooding, rapid river rises, and landslides, with significant potential for urban inundation.
