Subject: **SPECIAL SITUATION REPORT-1 (SITREP-1) RAIN SPELLS FROM 19 MARCH TO 8 APRIL 2026**

1. Heavy and intense late-winter and early-spring rainfall is increasingly emerging as a recurrent weather phenomenon in Pakistan. During the current season, a prolonged spell of rainfall commenced on **13 March 2026** and is expected to continue till 12 April 2026. According to available meteorological forecasts, the precipitation system consists of **five distinct spells**, affecting large parts of the country.
2. These rainfall episodes have triggered flash floods in local nullahs of Balochistan and Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and activated hill torrents in the Sulaiman Range, affecting adjoining districts of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Southern Punjab and Northeastern Balochistan. Persistent and intense rainfall has increased the risk of localized flooding, hailstorms, landslides in hilly areas and infrastructure disruptions. Notably, structural collapse particularly of roofs and walls weakened by prolonged moisture has been the primary cause of fatalities during the current spell. District-wise losses and damages are detailed at **Annex-A**.
